
Cups



People living in Toyama and Fuchu should bring their PET bottles to supermarkets and other participating collection centers. People living in Osawano, Ovama, Yatsuo, Yamada and Hosoiri should place their PET bottles in designated pickup locations.



It is not necessary to separate aluminum Separate broken bottles and medicine and steel cans. bottles as non-burnable garbage

People living in Ovama should enclose their PET bottles in designated garbage bags or semitransparent bags.

Hangers, tie-wraps, tanks, planters and toys do not qualify as plastic containers or packaging, therefore separate them as burnable garbage Bring white trays to participating supermarkets that offer collection.

Separate the garbage at right as burnable garbage

- · Paper with gold or silver leaf
- Paper that has waterproofing, covered with vinvl, etc. (Cup noodles, yogurt containers, ice cream containers, paper cups, etc.)

Practice the 3 Rs!

Reduce: Reduce garbage by not buying or accepting unnecessary items.

Reuse: Reuse what can still be used.

Recycle: Properly separate garbage so that contained resources can be recycled.

To prevent injury to garbage collectors and fires on trucks, prepare garbage as follows. Gas ranges

Heaters are not collected if still containing fuel. Remaining fuel can ignite and burn

Do not putitogether

After completely using all of the contents, do not make a hole in the can. Put only those cans in a clear plastic bag.

 Glass (Medicine bottles. mirrors, cups, plate glass, electronic thermometers. fluorescent tubes)

- Ceramics (Plates, bowls, etc.)
- Sharp edged items



Wrap the broken pieces or sharp edged items (knives, blades, broken glass, etc.) with paper

Please dispose of large amounts of garbage by dividing them into small lots and disposing them over a period of several garbage days. Liquids are not collected.

Dry leaves, remove dirt

and place in plastic bags.


