
Timing of evacuation actions to protect yourself

Evacuation information issued by the city and disaster prevention weather information issued by the national and prefectural governments are divided into five levels so that residents can understand the risk of disaster occurrence and take appropriate evacuation actions.

Disaster Risks: Low (Left) to High (Right)

*1 People who take time to evacuate: Includes the elderly and people with disabilities, etc.
 *2 Evacuation is recommended: Timing with a low risks of disaster Evacuation is not recommended: There is a high possibility that a disaster has occurred, safe evacuation is impossible.
 *3 Move to a room as far away from the cliff as possible or to a nearby solid building.



If you observe signs of landslide.

- If you observe signs of landslide.
- Evacuate outside Sediment Disaster Hazard Areas
- Evacuate to a safe place such as a designated emergency shelters*
- Contact the Toyama City Hall and Civil engineering office

*Let's consider how to evacuate to places other than those designated by Toyama City, such as relatives or acquaintances' houses in safe places.
