\*1 People who take time to evacuate: Includes the elderly and people with disabilities, etc.

\*3 Move to a room as far away from the cliff as possible or to a nearby solid building.




\*Let's consider how to evacuate to places other than those designated by Toyama City, such as relatives or acquaintances' houses in safe places.


